

Alice Hutto Memorial Scholarship Program

Alice Hutto was the first member of the Ladies Auxiliary to the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States from South Carolina to serve as National President. She served as National President in 1989 - 1990.

The fund was established June 30, 1991 when excess revenue from the National Presidents fund was returned to the Ladies Auxiliary VFW, Department of South Carolina. The funds were to be invested in a savings account or certificate of deposit.

The Council of Administration at the 2001 State Convention voted to use the revenues from the invested funds to provide a \$1000.00 scholarship annually to assist an eligible nursing student continue her or his education in the nursing profession.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) The applicant must be a United States citizen.
- 2) The applicant must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and have completed her or his first semester at an accredited school of nursing.
- 3) A list of personal reasons why he or she should be chosen for this scholarship must be included with application.
- 4) The application and all required attachments must be returned to the Department Chairman postmarked no later than April 15, 2017.
